

## L. Carl Filer, Jr., P.E.

*FDOT District Six Public Transportation Manager & MIC Program Manager*



L. Carl Filer, Jr. has spent his entire career in public service with the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT). He has extensive experience in the development and administration of grant programs to local governmental agencies for major capital projects involving seaports, airports, railroad companies and transit systems.

Mr. Filer joined the Department in 1978 as an Engineer I at the District Four Satellite Office in Miami, which later became District Six when it was created in July 1979. District Six encompasses Miami-Dade and Monroe counties. Over the past 33 years he has held positions of increasing responsibility in areas including

Project Development and Environment, Computer Center and Public Transportation.

Working with a \$60 million annual appropriation, Mr. Filer was responsible for developing the Department's Work Program for Public Transportation programs in accordance with its policies and procedures. The Work Program is the District's proposed schedule for projects and studies slated for the next five years. He has also prepared contracts to provide funding to local governments and monitored project schedules and construction activities.

Since 1987, Mr. Filer has been the Intermodal Administrator/Public Transportation Manager for District Six. In this capacity he is responsible for preparing budgets and variances, negotiating and administering contracts, evaluating major capital projects, implementing policies and procedures, dealing with transportation issues and hiring, training and directing a staff of five.

Mr. Filer was recently appointed by the District Secretary to manage completion of the \$1.7 billion Miami Intermodal Center (MIC) Program. In this new leadership role he directs FDOT's design and construction of the \$83 million Miami Central Station, Miami-Dade County's first all-inclusive ground transportation hub that will provide connections where none existed for Amtrak, Tri-Rail, Metrorail, Greyhound, Metrobus and others.

Mr. Filer and his wife are the parents of four children and have two grandchildren. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the University of Florida and is a registered Professional Engineer in the State of Florida. In his leisure time, Mr. Filer enjoys spending time with his family and traveling.
