FDOT TO SHOW AND TELL AT “CAPITAL FOR A DAY” IN MIAMI

MIAMI – The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will exhibit its latest model of the future Miami Intermodal Center (MIC) as part of the activities planned for “Capital for a Day” this Tuesday, June 25th from 11:00 – 2:00 p.m. at the Coconut Grove Exposition Center. In addition to the model and accompanying video, there will be information available on a number of other major road construction initiatives currently underway and in their final phases of design. “We are happy to have a forum where people can learn about our most important projects all at the same time,” said David Rosemond, FDOT spokesman. In addition to the Department of Transportation, other state agencies will provide information to the public.

Governor Jeb Bush schedules “Capital for a Day” in different cities around the state in order to provide the opportunity for citizens to learn more about what their government does at the state level. Governor Bush and the Florida Cabinet will meet first at City of Miami City Hall at 3500 Pan American Drive from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The Agency Fair will be held at the Coconut Grove Exposition Center, 2700 South Bayshore Drive, from 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. The public is encouraged to attend the fair to view the displays and meet with staff from the different state agencies.
