CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #1:

Temporary Nighttime Closure on Northbound LeJeune Road from South of NW 27th Street to South of NW 31st Street:

Commencing Thursday, June 8, 2006 at 9:00 P.M. through Friday, June 9, 2006 at 5:00 A.M.: As part of the Miami Intermodal Center Program's LeJeune Watermain Project, the northbound inside lane from south of NW 27th Street to south of NW 31st Street will be temporarily closed. Crews will be performing utility work on the new 16" watermain. Work will be performed by Solo Construction (Turner Construction) on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #2:

Nighttime Periodic Traffic Stops on Northbound and Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) at NW 21st Street:

Friday, June 9th, 2006 and Sunday, June 11th, 2006 from 11:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M.: As part of the MIC's LeJeune Road Corridor Projects - Package 2, there will be periodic traffic stops alternating northbound and southbound on LeJeune Road at NW 21st Street for a period of 5 to 10 minutes each while crews remove the existing concrete beams of the temporary bridge in order to construct the new bridge at this location. This work is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. Police officers will be on site to assist with the traffic stops. Work will be performed by Kiewit Southern Co. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY #3:

Nighttime Closures Alternating Northbound and Southbound SR-953/LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) from NW 11th Street to NW 14th Street:

Commencing Sunday, June 11, 2006 through Friday, June 16, 2006 from 10:00 P.M. to 5:30 A.M. (For a period of two nights only in each direction): As part of the MIC's LeJeune Road Corridor Projects - Package 2, **LeJeune Road (NW 42nd Avenue) from NW 11th Street to NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed for a period of two nights only alternating in the northbound and southbound direction. Access Only to Local Business between NW 11th Street and NW 14th Street will remain open at all times.** Motorists will need to follow the posted detour signs as outlined below:

Maintenance of Traffic Detour: Commuters traveling on **Southbound LeJeune Road** will need to follow the posted detour and turn right on NW 14th Street and continue west to NW 43rd Place and turn left, continue to NW 45th Avenue and turn left and continue south until NW 7th Street and turn left to continue to LeJeune Road and turn right to continue in the southbound direction. **Access to Westbound SR-836** should follow the above detour to access on-ramp at NW 45th Avenue. **Commuters traveling on Northbound LeJeune Road** will turn right on NW 7th Street and continue east to NW 37th Avenue, turn left and continue to NW 14th Street and turn left to continue to LeJeune Road and turn right to continue in the northbound direction. **Access to Eastbound SR-836** should follow the posted detour signs to NW 37th Avenue. **Northbound LeJeune Road Airport** traffic should follow the posted detour signs to NW 37th Avenue, turn left and continue to NW 21st Street and turn left to enter Miami International Airport.

This closure is required in order to install a new drainage pipe across LeJeune Road. This work is being done at night in order to lessen the impacts to the traveling public. Work will be performed by Kiewit Southern Corp. on behalf of the Florida Department of Transportation.

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program sponsored by the Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
