### CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

#### Temporary Closure of the Intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street

**From Wednesday, October 15, 2003 at 9:00 p.m. until Thursday, October 16, 2003 at 5:30 a.m.** the intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed. This temporary closure will be necessary in order to provide a well system for the drainage lines that will be installed during the following weekend. This well system is being installed to dewater the roadway as a safety precaution for the traveling public prior to the installation of the new drainage system. Local businesses and residential access will be maintained on the affected roadways. Southbound thru traffic on NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue should turn left at NW 14<sup>th</sup> Terrace, turn right at NW 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue, go straight until NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street and turn right to go back onto NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Northbound thru traffic on NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue should turn right at NW 11<sup>th</sup> Street, turn left at NW 34<sup>th</sup> Avenue, go straight until NW 14<sup>th</sup> Terrace and turn left to go back onto NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Crew working hours will be from 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. An off-duty police officer will be on site and Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters of detours and intersection closures. **This closure will again occur on Friday, October 17, 2003.**

#### Miami-Dade Expressway Authority (MDX) Project: Construction of an Additional Westbound Lane from SR-112 to Okeechobee Road Off-ramp

##### DATES: October 13, 2003 to October 18, 2003

**MAINLINE:** As part of the improvements to SR-112, there will be intermittent lane closures, one at a time, on westbound SR-112 between NW 32 Avenue and Okeechobee Road from Monday, October 13 to Saturday, October 18, 2003. These closures will be during non-peak hours from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Also, westbound on SR-112 at the NW 37<sup>th</sup> Avenue bridge, up to two lanes will be closed from Monday, October 13 to Saturday, October 18. One lane will be closed from 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. and the second lane will be closed from 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. Additionally on westbound SR-112 at the NW 37<sup>th</sup> Place Bridge, one lane will be closed from Tuesday, October 14 to Saturday, October 18 between the hours of 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. Motorists should look out for roadway detours.
