CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITIES UPDATE

Construction Activity No. 1:

NW 21st Street from NW 37th Avenue to NW 39th Avenue:

Commencing Friday, October 24, 2003 through Friday, November 7, 2003: The left westbound and left eastbound lanes including the center turning lanes along NW 21st Street, from approximately 400 feet west of NW 37th Avenue to NW 39th Avenue, will be temporarily closed. At least one lane in each direction will be maintained open to traffic. Access into and out of the properties located along the north and south sides of NW 21st Street will be restricted to right turns only. All other traffic will be detoured through alternative routes as shown on the attached Detour Map. This closure is due to the installation of a water main pipe for the Miami Intermodal Center Rental Car Facility. **Crew working hours will be during non-peak hours from 9:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.** Work is being performed by Turner Construction (Central Florida Utilities). Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters of lane closures.

Construction Activity No. 2:

Temporary Partial Ramp Closure for Eastbound SR-836 On-Ramp at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road):

Wednesday, October 22, 2003: The northern portion of the on-ramp to eastbound SR-836 will be temporarily closed from 6:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m. Traffic will be re-routed to the southern portion of the on-ramp to eastbound SR-836. This closure is due to drainage improvements for the NW 14th Street Construction Project. This work will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT.

Construction Activity No. 3:

Temporary Closure of NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court:

Commencing Monday, October 27, 2003 through Saturday, November 1, 2003: NW 14th Street from State Road 953/NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) to NW 42nd Court will be temporarily closed. Westbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road) up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Court. Eastbound traffic on NW 14th Street will be re-routed through NW 42nd Court up to NW 18th Street and out onto NW 42nd Avenue (LeJeune Road). All other traffic to follow posted detour signs. Temporary closure is due to installation of new sidewalks, curb and gutter, milling, resurfacing and paving activities. Work will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. **Crew working hours will be from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.** Variable Message Signs will be in place advising commuters of detours and lane closures.

Construction Activity No. 4:

Temporary Closure of the Intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street

From Wednesday, October 29, 2003 at 9:00 p.m. until Thursday, October 30, 2003 at 5:30 a.m. The intersection at NW 37th Avenue (Douglas Road) and NW 14th Street will be temporarily closed. This temporary closure will be necessary in order to provide a well system for the drainage lines that will be installed during the following weekend. This well system is being installed to dewater the roadway as a safety precaution for the traveling public prior to the installation of the new drainage system. Local businesses and residential access will be maintained on the affected roadways. Southbound thru traffic on NW 37th Avenue should turn left at NW 14th Terrace, turn right at NW 34th Avenue, go straight until NW 11th Street and turn right to go back onto NW 37th Avenue. Northbound thru traffic on NW 37th Avenue should turn right at NW 11th Street, turn left at NW 34th Avenue, go straight until NW 14th Terrace and turn left to go back onto NW 37th Avenue. **Crew working hours will be from 9:00 p.m. to 5:30 a.m.** This activity will be performed by APAC Construction for FDOT. An off-duty police officer will be on site and Variable Message Signs (VMS) will be in place advising commuters of detours and intersection closures. Only Emergency Vehicles will be provided access. **This closure will again occur on Friday, October 31, 2003.**

*Nearby business interests and residents affected by construction of the **Miami Intermodal Center** and other nearby construction projects will receive periodic Maintenance of Traffic (MOT) bulletins giving road closure information and suggesting alternate routes. This information is being provided by the **One Stop Shop Traffic Information Program** sponsored by the **Florida Department of Transportation** and its partnering agencies Miami-Dade County, Miami-Dade Aviation Department, Miami International Airport, Miami-Dade Expressway Authority, Tri-Rail, Miami-Dade Transit, Miami-Dade Office of Public Transportation Management, Cities of Miami, Hialeah, Miami Springs and Virginia Gardens, and local Utilities. Thank you for your patience while we work to improve the roadways in this area.
